The undersigned agrees to the following **details, descriptions and restrictions:**

1. No lasers, poppers, bomb bags, etc., **animals** or outside firewood allowed on Pow Wow grounds.
2. The sale of ceremonial items of any kind is strictly prohibited, including sage, and sweet grass.
3. Vendors are **responsible** for **set-up** and removal of **their own** equipment, fixtures, inventory and other property; maintenance of their area as well as the removal of all trash.
4. Vendors are **responsible** for providing their own chairs, lights, tables, tarps, trash bags, water pails and any other supplies. Vendors must supply their own generators and extension cords. One (1) adult 18yrs of age or older must be in the booth at all times.
5. **Motor vehicles are not allowed in the POW WOW area except to load or unload. Vendor parking is allowed only in Vendor Parking Area.**
6. **N.A.V.A. and its Board of Directors are not responsible for theft, damage or injuries to anyone associated with the signed vendor. Vendors assume liability for the above cases before, during and after the event. A Hold Harmless Agreement must be signed prior to set-up.**
7. Possession or use of **alcohol, drugs, or weapons** on Pow Wow property including any and all parking lots will not be tolerated, and will result in immediate expulsion from the property and forfeiture of all fees paid. Local authorities will be contacted for any criminal activity.
8. 24-hour security will be provided for the Pow Wow area; however vendors assume all liability for theft, loss, damage or injury.
9. Deposit must be paid by October 15<sup>th</sup> to secure spot, Payment in full is required by November 12th
10. All fees must be paid by Cashier's Check or Money Order only. No personal checks or cash no exceptions.
11. Overnight parking will need a permit. All Vendors will be given a permit when you sign in, please indicate the need on your application. Vendors will have assigned parking.
12. **75% of your merchandise must be handcrafted by Native American Indians (strictly enforced).**
13. Booths are pre assigned. **No moving. No exceptions.**
14. Management reserves all rights.
15. No open fires
